

Now that we're seeing a lot of new growth out on the course, I thought I would send you this picture. This is a picture of Pelican #3 gold tee which was pretty much down to dirt in March. As you can see, with a little bit of growing weather and some rain we have new sprigs coming up all over it.



With our aeration, top dressing and fertilizing programs this tee should be filled in with a good stand of turf over the summer. We will revisit this tee later on in another newsletter.

For those of you that are still here and playing, our aeration will start this week. We will be spiking the green slopes, tees, tee slopes and fairways on all three courses followed up with a wall to wall fertilization of the course and a wall to wall pre-emergent herbicide. We will also be starting our core aeration of greens with the Heron course. Each week as we close a course we will aerify those greens. As we spike the tees and fairways feel to take relief from the core plugs.
